Dear Kelly McClintock:

The Government of Saskatchewan continues to work closely with Saskatchewan Hockey Association (SHA) officials on the safety guidelines for return to hockey in Saskatchewan. Dr. Saqib Shahab, Saskatchewan's Chief Medical Health Officer, has reviewed and accepted the following approach.

Hockey competition may continue as per the guidelines in the Re-Open Saskatchewan plan and the Saskatchewan Hockey Association's Safety Guidelines. Maximum attendance will remain at 150 spectators in Saskatchewan rinks provided there is enough room to maintain appropriate physical distancing in all areas of the arena – for all levels of hockey played within the province. The spectator capacity will remain in effect through December 4, 2020.

As Dr. Shahab has noted previously, the COVID-19 situation remains fluid in the province. While the safety guidelines have been accepted, it's important to note they are subject to change based on COVID-19 conditions in Saskatchewan. Government officials will continue to work with the SHA.
