Dear Kelly McClintock:

The Government of Saskatchewan has been working closely with Saskatchewan Hockey Association (SHA) officials on the safety guidelines for return to hockey in Saskatchewan. Dr. Saqib Shahab, Saskatchewan's Chief Medical Health Officer, has reviewed and accepted the guidelines from the SHA.

Hockey competition may continue, and mini-league sizes can increase to six teams (consisting of the maximum number of players allowed within the SHA regulations) or 80 players per mini-league, effective November 1, 2020. However, maximum attendance will remain at 150 spectators in Saskatchewan rinks provided there is enough room to maintain appropriate physical distancing in all areas of the arena. The spectator capacity is effective October 17, 2020, and will remain in effect through November 13, 2020.

As Dr. Shahab has noted previously, the COVID-19 situation remains fluid in the province. While the safety guidelines have been accepted, it's important to note they are subject to change based on COVID-19 conditions in Saskatchewan. Government officials will continue to work with the SHA.
