



Referee's Division Bursary Application

The SHA Referee's Division shall award three (3) \$1,000.00 Bursaries each hockey season to three registered officials of the SHA Referee's Division to assist with the costs of post-secondary education.

The SHA Referee's Division three (3) are as follows:

- 1 – SODM (Saskatchewan Officiating Development Model) official working Elite hockey in SODM leagues
- 1 – Northern official (Zones 5-8) working grassroots, minor or senior hockey
- 1 – Southern official (Zones 1-4) working grassroots, minor or senior hockey

Each applicant will be required to fill out and return an application form to the SHA Office (Attn: Manager, Officiating) before the application deadline of each hockey season. Each applicant will be placed into one of the three pools and one name will be drawn from each pool to receive the bursary. The draw will be completed at the Semi-Annual Meeting of the Referee's Division in January. Only completed applications will be considered for the draw.

The recipients of the bursaries will be selected and announced following the Semi-Annual Meeting of the Referee's Division each hockey season.

Application forms may be obtained from any Referee's Division clinic, through the SHA website or by contacting the SHA Manager, Officiating.

The applicant must meet all of the following criteria:

1. Must be attending post-secondary education including university, college, trade, or technical schools that require tuition to be paid.
2. Must be a member in good standing with the SHA's Referee's Division.
3. Must have attended Post Secondary School Between January 1, 2018 and December 31, 2018 or have made payment for tuition during that time.
4. Recipients may only receive the bursary once
